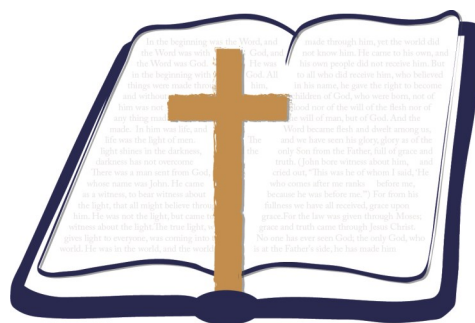

The Pattern of Discipleship

"And what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also." – 2 Timothy 2.2

Our church's mission is to "make disciples to the glory of God." This is something that stands behind everything we do in every program here at the church. And while this must always be our goal for times of large gatherings at the church, this also must be the goal of the daily life of our entire church body. We must not only have programs that make disciples to the glory of God, we must have each individual member making disciples to the glory of God.

Paul lays out for Timothy the pattern of how the baton of "the faith once for all delivered to the saints" (Jude 1.3) gets handed from one generation of believers to the next. Yes, corporate programs play a part, but also intentional individual relationships of discipleship are crucial. Paul (generation 1) taught Timothy (generation 2). Then, what Timothy heard from Paul, he was to entrust to faithful men (generation 3). And part of that entrusting the gospel to faithful men was expecting them to one day be able to teach others also (generation 4).

I want to ask us as a church, does this kind of pattern describe our lives? Many of us have had a "Paul" (or multiple "Pauls") who have over many years faithfully taught us what it means to live as one, called to be a life-long fully devoted follower of Christ. Are we now entrusting that understanding of the gospel and living out the Christian life to someone else? Who might that be in your life?

There are others of us that are perhaps young in our faith. We think that there are many things that we still have yet to learn about the "faith once for all delivered to the saints." But let me encourage even the newest Christian in our church to always be thinking as you learn: "I want to know more of Christ, not only so that I can love him more, but so that I can teach others to love him more as well."

All believers are called to make disciples to the glory of God. Are you entrusting what you have heard to others? The baton of the faith must never be dropped from one generation of saints to the next!
